

ANNUAL REPORT OF JR. WARDEN OF ST. JAMES VESTRY FOR 2018:

2018 was a busy and very productive year, as substantial new improvements, as well as the completion of previously committed work initiated by John Glover, Jr. Warden in 2017, were made to St. James Campus, buildings and grounds.

New exterior directional and locational signage around the campus were installed, and new directional and parking signage will be installed this month

A new entrance sign to the Church on Section Street is in the "works", and is expected to be in place by the upcoming Diocesan Convention in February

The Sanctuary floors were completely refinished in May, 2018

The Rose Window in the Choir loft was completely removed, replaced and reframed with new, higher quality insulated and tinted glass panels

Substantial renovation and repairs were made to the Sanctuary, Altar and Sacristy windows

Improvements were made in the Sacristy with the installation of new sink faucets and improved lighting fixtures, and additional improvements are in the works for both the Altar and Flower Guild to improve their work areas and storage

A covered portico was added to the rear entrance, providing a much needed, and more handicapped accessible entry to the Church, as well as for drop-off for the School, through a prior generous specific bequest from life-long Parishioner Roberta Billie

The front sidewalk providing entry to the Sanctuary was completed renovated and relocated, providing a much needed "gentler" slope for accessibility to the Campus and Sanctuary

The rear entrance to the Church and School received a much-needed landscape renovation, as well as the beds along the "breezeway" entrance to the Sanctuary, and numerous other shrubs around the Campus were replaced

New concrete steps and ramp were installed to provide safer and more accessible entrance to the storage area behind the Kitchen

The outside storage building was moved from its previous site on the playground to allow for the playground renovation

The exterior wooden doors to the Sanctuary and Chapel were refinished and restored to their original beauty and condition

The upstairs Choir hallway and downstairs Bathroom hallway in Green Hall received a much-needed new coat of paint

Many other improvements to the Campus are in the works, and hope to be realized, with HIS help, in the coming year
